

The Court, having noted the appearance of Deputy Attorney General Michael Yi on behalf of the Applicant Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education, having read and considered the moving papers, oral and written arguments, and having heard and considered any objections on behalf of Defendant Rene Carlos Aguero, finds that good cause supports the application of the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education pursuant to Penal Code Section 23, and that under the current circumstances it is appropriate to impose reasonable restrictions on Defendant, in the interest of public protection.

This condition shall remain in effect until there is a final disposition of this criminal case or until further ordered by the Court.
