The school’s website states “approval” in several locations without including a link to the bureau’s website.</p> <p>To remedy the violation, the institution shall update the School Performance Fact Sheets to 2019-2020 and add a link to the bureau’s website anywhere the institution identifies itself as being approved by the bureau. A link to the school’s website along with the last page of this document shall be submitted by the due date listed below.</p>
§94897 - Prohibited Business Practices.	<p>An institution shall not do any of the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Use the terms “approval,” “approved,” “approval to operate,” or “approved to operate” without stating clearly and conspicuously that approval to operate means compliance with state standards as set forth in this chapter. If the bureau has granted an institution approval to operate, the institution may
