19 TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES:

20 1. On or about April 7, 2015, Joanne Wenzel, Chief of the Bureau for Private
21 Postsecondary Education, Department of Consumer Affairs (Bureau), filed Statement of Issues
22 No. 1000017 solely in her official capacity.

23 2. On or about December 29, 2010, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education
24 received an Application for Renewal of Approval to Operate and Offer Educational Programs for
25 Non-Accredited Institutions from Consulting Advantage, Inc., dba TDA Educational Systems,
26 Inc., formerly Truck Driving Academy (Respondent). On or about February 8, 2012, and
27 September 20, 2012, the Bureau issued deficiency letters to Respondent explaining the
28 deficiencies in its application. On or about October 1, 2012, the Bureau received a response from

1 Respondent. On August 16, 2013, the Bureau sent another deficiency letter to Respondent. On
2 or about October 1, 2013, June 26, 2014, and July 3, 2014, the Bureau received additional
3 responses from Respondent. On August 22, 2014, the Bureau sent Respondent a Notice of
4 Denial of Application for Renewal of Approval to Operate. On or about October 1, 2014,
5 Respondent sent the Bureau a letter requesting an administrative hearing.

6 3. The basis for withdrawing the pending Statement of Issues No. 1000017 is that
7 Respondent has now provided the documents and other information necessary for its renewal of
8 licensure.

9 4. WHEREFORE, IN THE INTERESTS OF JUSTICE, Statement of Issues No.
10 1000017 is hereby withdrawn without prejudice.
