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1. Cancellation occurs when the student provides a written notice of cancellation at the address of attendance stated on the enrollment agreement. 2. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement.
3. You have the right to cancel your course of instruction, without any penalty or obligation, through attendance at the first-class session (the Course Start Date on p. 1 of Enrollment Agreement) or seven days after enrollment (the execution date of Enrollment Agreement), whichever comes later.
