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- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

The student shall have the right to cancel an agreement for a program of instruction that is subject of the agreement including any equipment, without any penalty or obligations, through attendance at the first class session or the seventh calendar day after enrollment, whichever is later.

The student can voluntarily terminate from the School by notifying the School in writing at Pima Medical Institute, 111 Campus Way, San Marcos, CA 92078. The effective date of termination is the date of proper mailing of student's notification, or the date the written notice is hand-delivered to the school. Refunds are calculated from the last date of attendance.

If the student fails to return issued materials, then the student will be responsible for the cost of those materials. Uniforms which have been worn may not be returned. Withdrawal may be effectuated by the student's written notice or by the student's conduct, including, but not limited to, a student's lack of attendance of 14 consecutive days or more or failure to return from Leave of Absence.

After the cancellation period, you also have the right to stop school at any time; and you have the right to receive a pro rata refund if you have completed 60 percent or less of the scheduled days in the current payment period in your program through the last day of attendance.
