26 timely appealed.

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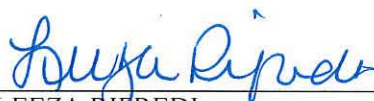
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3. Complainant withdraws the pending Statement of Issues No. 1001848 on the ground that Respondent has now provided the documents and other information necessary to proceed with the application process.
