

**Institutions With Temporary Approvals As Of June 30, 2007  
Issued By The Bureau For Private Postsecondary And Vocational  
Education (BPPVE)**

The California Private Postsecondary Education Act of 2009 (Act) does not include a designation of "temporary approval". If your institution had not been granted a full approval to operate by the BPPVE, prior to the sunset of the Private Postsecondary and Vocational Education Reform Act of 1989, your application will be deemed pending.

Section 94809(a)(1) of the Act provides that an institution that had an application pending on June 30, 2007 may continue to operate but shall comply with, and is subject to, the Act, and shall submit an application for approval to operate to the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) within six months of applications becoming available. Section 94809(a)(2) of the Act further provides that the Bureau may determine that the pending application for an approval to operate satisfies the requirements for a new application. Therefore, **please do not submit a new application for approval to operate unless you are requested to do so by the Bureau.** To assist the Bureau in determining whether your institution will need to submit a new application, we are requesting that you complete the enclosed Institution Information Update form and return it to the Bureau by February 1, 2010.

Section 94809(c) of the Act requires institutions with pending applications for approval to operate, notify students seeking to enroll, of the status of the institution's pending application. The Bureau recommends the following language for the required notice: **"This institution's application for approval to operate has not yet been reviewed by the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education."**

Please Note: If your institution has a pending application for approval to operate, and continues to operate under the Act, the institution **may not** use the terms "approval," "approval to operate," or "approved to operate" without clearly stating that the institution's application for approval has not been reviewed by the Bureau.
