ADVANCE NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE EMERGENCY REGULATIONS

To All Interested Parties:

Government Code section 11346.1(a)(2) requires that, at least five (5) working days prior to submission of the proposed emergency action to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL), the adopting agency provide a notice of the proposed emergency action to every person who has filed a request for notice of regulatory action with the agency. After submission of the proposed emergency to OAL, OAL shall allow interested persons five (5) calendar days to submit comments on the proposed emergency regulations as set forth in the Government Code section 11349.6.

Attached is the Proposed Emergency Regulation Text by the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) relating to the Application for Registration of Out-of-State Institutions form, which is incorporated by reference. Also attached is the Bureau's Finding of Emergency.

The Bureau plans to file the Emergency Rulemaking Package with OAL at least five (5) working days from the date of this notice. If you would like to make comments on the Finding of Emergency or the Proposed Emergency Regulation Text, both the Bureau and OAL must receive them within five (5) calendar days of the Bureau's filing with OAL. Responding to the comments at this point in the process is strictly at the Bureau's discretion.
