Definitions

- "Number of Students Who Began the Program" means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- "Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).
- "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- "Graduates Unavailable for Employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the
 applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the
 institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an
 examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination
 available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- "Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.

- "First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.
- "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.

- "Salary" is as reported by graduate or graduate's employer.
- "No Salary Information Reported" is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL:

- 1. A student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of tuition charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh business day after enrollment, whichever is later.
- 2. If a student terminates his training program after the initial seven day period, the institution will refund any unearned tuition on a **pro-rata basis**.
- 3. Cancellation shall occur when the student provides a written notice of cancellation at the following address: Modesto Technical College, 1300 No. 9th Street, Ste. #D, Modesto, CA 95350. This can be done by mail or hand delivery.
- 4. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with proper postage.
- 5. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form, and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows the student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement. Each student will be given one Notice of Cancellation forms to use upon enrollment, but any written notice may be used.
- 6. If the Enrollment Agreement is cancelled by midnight of the seventh business day on which the student attended his/her first class (business day is a day on which a student is scheduled to attend a class session), the school will refund the student any money he/she paid, less any deduction for equipment not returned in good condition, and less any nonrefundable STRF fee paid within 30 days after the notice of cancellation is received.
- 7. Modesto Technical College does not grant refunds for books or tools.
- 8. Students who fail to show on the first day of class or fail to show will be considered cancelled and the institution will void the contract without any financial obligation from the student. Any monies by the student will be refunded per refund policy.
