STUDENTS' RIGHT TO CANCEL

REFUND POLICY and STUDENTS' RIGHT TO CANCEL*

*All students must complete a course cancelation request.

Before the start date or on the first day of your course: If our office receives written cancelation (by letter or email) of your enrollment prior to the start of the session, or on the first day of class or the seventh day after enrollment (whichever is later), you will be entitled to a 100% refund less the \$150 registration fee, and the accommodation placement fee of \$95, if applicable (total institutional funds retained by St Giles not to exceed \$250). Express mail, airport transfer and insurance payments are non-refundable. See also below under **housing cancelation** regarding the cancelation of homestay or hotel/residence hall accommodation.

After your course begins: You can withdraw from a course after arrival by giving our office four weeks' written notice from the following Monday (thus it is not possible to withdraw from courses of 4 weeks or less). Your end-of-course date will be adjusted to the end of the week when cancellation takes effect. If this period represents **60% or less** of the original period booked, the fees due will be recalculated on a *pro rata* basis, and you will receive a refund of the balance. There is no refund if more than 60% of a course is completed.

St Giles does not participate in federal or state financial aid programs.

St. Giles will pay or credit refunds, not to exceed 45 days following the date upon which the student withdrawal has been determined. If you have booked your course through an agent, then your agent will notify us of the refund due.

Terms & Conditions for the CELTA Teacher Training Course

There are no additional fees or taxes added. Course fees are inclusive of the Cambridge Candidacy Fee, the Enrollment Fee, tuition fees as well as photocopying facilities and teaching resources used on the course. In addition, candidates will be given the book "Teaching English Worldwide" (Lindsay) when their course begins, but it is also advisable to buy other books for reference before, during and after the course. Advice on reference books will be given to you by the trainers. (You will need basic stationery to make notes; this is not included in your course fees.)

- 1. All applicants will be asked to attend an interview before an offer of a place can be made.
- 2. After being offered a place on one of our courses, you need to pay a deposit of \$250 (inclusive of \$100 Enrollment Fee and \$108 Cambridge Candidacy Fee) or the full fees in order to reserve a place.
- 3. Acceptance onto our CELTA program remains valid for one year. Although your deposit is non-refundable, it can be transferred to a later course until 30 days before your course start date. Within 30 days, however, it would become non-refundable and non-transferable. We also only allow students to transfer their deposit once.
- 4. A Pre-Course Task booklet is given to CELTA applicants when they have paid their deposit. You are expected to complete the required home study using the Pre-Course Task booklet before the beginning of your chosen course.
- 5. Full fees must be paid at least 30 days before the course begins (N.B. under no circumstances will anyone be allowed to start a course unless full fees have been received). Applicants are reminded by e-mail during the week preceding this.
- 6. If a student cancels his or her place on a course more than 30 days before the start of the course, full fees will be refunded minus the deposit. Further refunds cannot be made either before, during or after the course, except in the case of course cancellation by the St Giles.
- 7. St Giles reserves the right to cancel a course for which numbers of participants do not meet the minimum requirement, in which case we will offer an alternative course, or refund full fees and deposits.
