Cancellation shall occur when a student gives a written notice of cancellation by mail, hand-delivered or emailed. If the student has received any books, uniforms, equipment or other materials, these items must be returned to the school within 10 days following the date of notice of cancellation. If the student fails to return any books, uniforms, equipment or other materials in good condition within 10-day period, the school may deduct its cost from any refund that may be due to the student. Once the student has paid for and received any of the above, they become her/his property and the school has no further obligation in that regard. If the student cancels the agreement, MSI will refund within 30 days from the date of the notice of cancellation received any money that the student paid minus registration fee, and any deduction for any books, uniforms, equipment and other materials not returned in good condition.
