Definitions

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

A student, legal guardian, or sponsor has the right to cancel the Enrollment Agreement by written notice and obtain a refund of charges paid except the \$100.00 non-refundable registration fee & STRF through attendance at the first-class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, from the date the enrollment agreement was signed, whichever is later. The school shall refund any amount paid by the student within 45 days after it receives the notice of cancellation. Notice of cancellation may be given by mail, hand delivered, or fax. The notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail, properly addressed with postage prepaid. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, is effective if it states that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the Agreement.

REFUND POLICY Applies to all terminations for any reason by either party. After the cancellation period, the institution provides a pro rata refund of funds paid for tuition charges to students who have completed 60 percent or less of the period of attendance.
