**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF**  
**STATEMENT OF ISSUES**

21 **TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES:**

22 1. On or about December 13, 2013, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education  
23 ("Bureau") received an Application for Renewal of Approval to Operate and Offer Educational  
24 Programs for Non-Accredited Institutions from Respondent A-1 Truck Driving School Inc., also  
25 known as A 1 Truck Driving School, Inc. ("Respondent"), a California corporation. Between  
26 January 2014 and July 2017, the Bureau and Respondent conferred regarding Respondent's  
27 application, including Respondent's transmittal of additional application materials. The Bureau  
28 denied the application via a Notice of Denial of Application for Renewal of Approval to Operate

1 on or about August 15, 2017. On or about September 28, 2017, Respondent submitted to the  
2 Bureau a request for administrative hearing.

3 2. On or about January 26, 2018, Dr. Michael Marion, Jr., Chief of the Bureau for  
4 Private Postsecondary Education, Department of Consumer Affairs, filed Statement of Issues No.  
5 1002980 solely in his official capacity. The Bureau subsequently amended the Statement of  
6 Issues. The current pleading is the Third Amended Statement of Issues No. 1002980. After  
7 initiating this action, Respondent provided additional documents and information intended to  
8 resolve the issues of non-compliance in Respondent's application.

9 3. The Bureau hereby withdraws Third Amended Statement of Issues No. 1002980. The  
10 basis for the withdrawal of this pleading is that Respondent has now provided the documents and  
11 other information necessary for its application for licensure to be in compliance with the law.

12 4. WHEREFORE, IN THE INTERESTS OF JUSTICE, Third Amended Statement of  
13 Issues No. 1002980 is hereby withdrawn without prejudice.
