2	5 CCR § 71810 (b)(15) in conjunction with CEC § 94897 (s)	<p>Violation Description: The institution’s 2025 catalog contains the following unenforceable statement:</p> <p>“No transcript will be issued until all tuition and other fees due the institution are paid current.”</p> <p>This is a violation of the civil code.</p> <p>Correction: The institution shall remove the above statement, pursuant to 5 CCR § 71810 (b)(15) in conjunction with CEC § 94897 (s).</p>
3	CEC § 94909 (a)(8)(B) in conjunction with CEC § 94920 (b)	<p>Violation Description: The institution’s 2025 catalog contains the statement “Books and Materials \$150 (non refundable)” in multiple locations. This is unenforceable during the cancellation period. the student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. Institutions shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or application fee not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), if notice of cancellation is made through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.</p> <p>Correction: The institution shall update their 2025 catalog to identify those charges as refundable during the cancellation period, or remove the nonrefundable designation, pursuant to CEC § 94909 (a)(8)(B) in conjunction with CEC § 94920 (b).</p>

8	CEC § 94911 (e)(1) in conjunction with CEC § 94920 (b)	<p>Violation Description: The institution’s enrollment agreement contain the statement “Books and Materials \$150 (non refundable)”. This is unenforceable during the cancellation period. the student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later and institutions shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or application fee not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), if notice of cancellation is made through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.</p> <p>Correction: The institution shall update their enrollment agreement to identify those charges as refundable during the cancellation period, or remove the nonrefundable designation, pursuant to CEC § 94911 (e)(1) in conjunction with CEC § 94920 (b).</p>
9	CEC § 94913 (a)(4)	<p>Violation Description: The institution’s website failed to contain a link to the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education’s website.</p> <p>Correction: The institution shall update their website to include a link to the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education’s website, pursuant to CEC § 94913 (a)(4).</p>
10	CEC § 94913 (a)(1)	<p>Violation Description: Following correction of the above minor catalog violations, the institution’s website will no longer contain a link to or copy of their most recent catalog.</p> <p>Correction: The institution shall update their website to include a link to or copy of their current catalog, following the Above corrections, pursuant to CEC § 94913 (a)(1).</p>

Pursuant to 5 CCR section 75010(d), the Institution may do either of the following:

- (1) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, sign and return the notice to comply, declaring under penalty of perjury that the violation was corrected and describing how compliance was achieved; or
- (2) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, file with the Bureau a written notice of disagreement, specifying the minor violations described in the notice to comply with which the person approved to operate the institution disagrees, and appealing it by requesting an

informal office conference. If a written notice of disagreement is not timely filed with the Bureau, the right to appeal is deemed to have been waived.

Pursuant to CEC section 94935(h), failure to comply with the notice to comply will result in the Bureau taking appropriate administrative enforcement action.

The Notice to Comply was given to the Institution’s owner, person in control, chief academic officer, chief executive officer, chief operating officer, institution director, or any person delegated by any of the aforementioned persons to facilitate the inspection or accept such notice as set forth below.
