On March 14, 2019, an informal telephone conference was held in the matter of Citation: Order of Abatement No. 1819107 (Citation) against California Preparatory College, Inc., owner of California Preparatory College (Institution). In attendance were Beth Scott, Bureau Chief, and Gene Edelbach, CEO of California Preparatory College.

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code, §125.9; California Education Code, §94936; and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations, §75020 and §75040, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) renders the following decision relative to your appeal of the Citation No. 1819107.

It is the decision of the Bureau Chief that on March 21, 2019 Citation No. 1819107 is affirmed for the following reason(s):

- No new substantive facts were presented at the conference.

VIOLATION CODE SECTIONS

#	The California Education Code (CEC) and the California Code of Regulations (CCR). Below you will find the section(s) you are charged with violating.
1.	<p><u>Violation:</u> CEC Section 94885(a)(6) and (9)– Minimum Operating Standards <i>“(a) The bureau shall adopt by regulation minimum operating standards for an institution that shall reasonably ensure that all of the following occur: [...]</i> <i>(6) The institution is financially sound and capable of fulfilling its commitments to students. [...]</i> <i>(9) The institution is maintained and operated in compliance with this chapter and all other applicable ordinances and laws.”</i></p> <p>5, CCR Section 71745(a)(6)- Financial Resources. <i>“(a) The institution shall document that it has at all times sufficient assets and financial resources to</i></p>

do all of the following: [...]

(6) Maintain a ratio of current assets to current liabilities of 1.25 to 1.00 or greater at the end of the most recent fiscal year when using generally accepted accounting principles, or for an institution participating in Title IV of the federal Higher Education Act of 1965, meet the composite score requirements of the U.S. Department of Education. For the purposes of this section, current assets does not include: intangible assets, including goodwill, going concern value, organization expense, startup costs, long-term prepayment of deferred charges, and non-returnable deposits, or state or federal grant or loan funds that are not the property of the institution but are held for future disbursement for the benefit of students. Unearned tuition shall be accounted for in accordance with general accepted accounting principles.”

For the reasons stated above, the institution is in violation of these sections of law.

Order of Abatement:

The Bureau orders the institution to:

1. Submit a detailed plan to address its financial shortfalls and to [meet the ratio of current assets to current liabilities of 1.25 to 1.00 or greater at the end of the most recent fiscal year in accordance with 5, CCR 71745(a)(6)]
2. In addition, please provide an explanation of all measures to be taken by the Institution to ensure it meets future financial responsibilities.
3. Please provide the Bureau with, in electronic format:
 - a) a roster of all currently enrolled students that includes the student (1) names, (2) addresses, (3) telephone numbers, (4) email addresses, (5) program in which they are enrolled, (6) date of enrollment, (7) total cost of the program and (8) the total amount the student has paid.

On March 7, 2019, the Bureau received and accepted the Order of Abatement submitted by the Institution.




