1	CEC § 94909 (a)(4)	Violation Description: The institution's 2022-2025 catalog failed to specify the address or addresses where class sessions will be held.
		Correction: The institution shall update its 2022-2025 catalog to include the specific address where class sessions will be held, pursuant to CEC § 94909 (a)(4).
2	CEC § 94909 (a)(12)	Violation Description: The institution's 2022-2025 catalog failed to contain a statement specifying whether or not the institution is operating as a debtor in possession, or has had a petition in bankruptcy filed against it within the preceding five years that resulted in reorganization under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code (11 U.S.C. Sec. 1101 et seq.). Correction: The institution shall update its 2022-2025 catalog to include the above-mentioned statements, pursuant to CEC § 94909 (a)(12).

8	CEC § 94909 (a)(9) in conjunction with 5 CCR § 76120 (a)	Violation Description: The institution's 2022-2025 catalog failed to identify STRF fee in the list of itemized charges. Correction: The institution shall update its 2022-2025 catalog, to include the current STRF value pursuant to CEC § 94909 (a)(9) in conjunction with 5 CCR § 76120 (a).
9	5 CCR § 76215 (a) in conjunction with 5 CCR § 76215 (b)	Violation Description: The institution's 2022 catalog failed to include the required verbatim language regarding the Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF). Correction: The institution shall update its 2024 catalog to include the above-mentioned required verbatim language pursuant to 5 CCR § 76215 (a) in conjunction with 5 CCR § 76215 (b).
10	5 CCR § 76120 (a)	Violation Description: The institution's 2022-2025 catalog incorrectly identifies the STRF fee on page 9, as" \$2.50 per \$1,000 of institutional charges". The current fee is listed as "\$0.00 per \$1,000 of institutional charge." Correction: The institution shall update its 2022-2025 catalog, to include the current STRF value pursuant to 5 CCR § 76120 (a).

		Correction: The institution shall update its 2024 catalog, to include the above-mentioned statement pursuant to CEC § 94909 (a)(3)(D).
16	5 CCR § 71800 (e) in conjunction with CEC § 94920 (b)	Violation Description: The institution's enrollment agreement contains unenforceable statements regarding non-refundable items. It is implied that the items listed in the itemized list of chares are non-refundable within the cancellation period. According to CEC § 94920 (b), the law identifies a reasonable deposit or application fee as the only non-refundable items within the cancellation period.
		Correction: The institution shall update the itemization section in its enrollment agreements pursuant to 5 CCR § 71800 (e) in conjunction with CEC § 94920 (b).
17	5 CCR § 71800 (e)(11) in conjunction with 5 CCR § 76120	Violation Description: Although the institution's enrollment agreement identifies the STRF fee in the list of itemized charges, the fee is incorrectly identified as "\$12.50". The current fee is listed as "\$0.00 per \$1,000 of institutional charge."
		Correction: The institution shall update its enrolment agreement, to include the current STRF value pursuant to 5 CCR § 71800 (e)(11) in conjunction with 5 CCR § 76120.

18	CEC § 94911 (e)(2) in conjunction with CEC § 94920 (b)	Violation Description: Page 2 of the institution's enrollment agreement contains an unenforceable policy specifying the return equipment within a certain timeframe and specific condition within the cancellation period as potential nonrefundable items. The policy is not compliant with CEC § 94920 (b), as 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or application fee not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), must be refunded.
		Correction: The institution shall update the enrollment agreement to include the above-mentioned policies pursuant to CEC § 94911 (e)(2) in conjunction with CEC § 94920 (b).
19	CEC §94911 (j)(1)	Violation Description: Although the institution's enrollment agreement contains the required statement, the Bureau's address is incorrect.
		Correction: The institution shall update its enrolment agreement, to include the correct address for the Bureau value pursuant to CEC §94911 (j)(1).
20	CEC § 94913 (a)(1)	Violation Description: The institution's website failed to provide the institution's 2022-2025 catalog.
		Correction: The institution shall update its website, to include the institution's 2022-2025 catalog pursuant to CEC § 94913 (a)(1).
21	CEC § 94913 (a)(2)	Violation Description: The institution failed to post on its website clear and conspicuous links to the school's 2021/2022 School Performance Fact Sheets for the "Medical Assisting" program offered by the school.
		Correction: The institution shall update its website to include a clear and conspicuous link to the school's 2021/2022 School Performance Fact Sheets for the "Medical Assisting" program offered by the school pursuant to CEC § 94913 (a)(2).

		Correction: The institution shall update its website to include a clear and conspicuous link to the school's 2022 annual report pursuant to CEC § 94913 (a)(5).
23	CEC § 94897 (o)	Violation Description: The "Request Information" section on the institution's website, contains a prohibitive business practice regarding requiring a prospective student to provide personal contact information in order to obtain, from the institution's internet website, educational program information that is required to be contained in the school catalog.
		Correction: The institution shall update its website, to remove the above-mentioned requirement pursuant to CEC § 94897 (o).
24	CEC § 94897 (s)	Violation Description: The "Policy For Obtaining a Transcript or Diploma Withheld Because of a Financial Hold" document on the institution's website contains an unenforceable policy regarding withholding a transcript until the student is current on all financial obligations. In accordance with CEC § 94897 (s) and Civil Code section 1788.93, an institution cannot require a student to satisfy financial obligations or make arrangements for payment prior to providing a transcript to a student.
		Correction: The institution shall remove the noncompliant policy from the website pursuant with CEC § 94897 (s).
25	5 CCR § 71760	Violation Description: The institution failed to develop and maintain adequate procedures used by the institution to assure that it is maintained and operated in compliance with the Act and this Division.
		Correction: The institution shall update their policies to include the above-mentioned policy in a documentable form.

Pursuant to 5 CCR section 75010(d), the Institution may do either of the following:

- (1) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, sign and return the notice to comply, declaring under penalty of perjury that the violation was corrected and describing how compliance was achieved; or
- (2) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, file with the Bureau a written notice of disagreement, specifying the minor violations described in the notice to comply with which the person approved to operate the institution disagrees, and appealing it by requesting an informal office conference. If a written notice of disagreement is not timely filed with the Bureau, the right to appeal is deemed to have been waived.

Pursuant to CEC section 94935(h), failure to comply with the notice to comply will result in the Bureau taking appropriate administrative enforcement action.

The Notice to Comply was given to the Institution's owner, person in control, chief academic officer, chief executive officer, chief operating officer, institution director, or any person delegated by any of the aforementioned persons to facilitate the inspection or accept such notice as set forth below.
