The University will withhold official transcripts if the University has knowledge that the student has any default on loans or service obligations." In accordance with CEC § 94897 (s) and Civil Code section 1788.93, an institution cannot require a student to satisfy financial obligations or make arrangements for payment prior to providing a transcript to a student. The statement in the catalog does not comply with CEC § 94897 (s). Correction: The institution shall remove the noncompliant statement from the catalog. The institution's policy must demonstrate compliance with 5 CCR 71810 (b)(15) and CEC § 94897 (s).
9	CEC § 94909 (a)(3)(D)	Violation Description: The institution's 2024-2025 catalog addendum, failed to contain the required verbatim statement: "The Office of Student Assistance and Relief is available to support prospective students, current students, or past students of private postsecondary educational institutions in making informed decisions, understanding their rights, and navigating available services and relief options. Pursuant to 5 CCR section 75010(d), the Institution may do either of the following:

- (1) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, sign and return the notice to comply, declaring under penalty of perjury that the violation was corrected and describing how compliance was achieved; or
- (2) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, file with the Bureau a written notice of disagreement, specifying the minor violations described in the notice to comply with which the person approved to operate the institution disagrees, and appealing it by requesting an informal office conference. If a written notice of disagreement is not timely filed with the Bureau, the right to appeal is deemed to have been waived.

Pursuant to CEC section 94935(h), failure to comply with the notice to comply will result in the Bureau taking appropriate administrative enforcement action.
