		<b>Correction:</b> The institution shall provide an annually updated catalog. It must contain the specific beginning and ending dates defining the time period covered by the catalog, pursuant to, 5 CCR § 71810 (a) in conjunction with 5 CCR § 71810 (b)(1).
4	5 CCR § 71810 (a)	Violation Description: The institution's policy for updating the catalog fails to comply with an annually updated catalog, pursuant to 5 CCR § 71810 (a). Page 5 of the catalog states, "The Catalog is updated regularly" And "Fees, deadlines, academic requirements, courses, degree programs, academic policies, and other matters described in this Catalog may change without notice."
		Correction: The institution shall revise its policy regarding catalog updates so that it is compliant with 5 CCR § 71810 (a). Meaning, if changes in educational programs, educational services, procedures, or policies required to be included in the catalog by statute or regulation are implemented before the issuance of the annually updated catalog, those changes shall be reflected at the time they are made in supplements or inserts accompanying the catalog.

6	5 CCR § 71750 (a)	Violation Description: The institution's catalog includes a separate refund policy for students who are on academic suspension or dismissal status, it states they are not eligible for refunds of tuition or fees. This is less than the refunds required under the Act and this Division, pursuant to 5 CCR § 71750 (a).
		<b>Correction:</b> The institution shall update the catalog by removing the following conflicting verbiage on page 68, "Students on academic suspension or dismissal status are not eligible for refunds of tuition or fees." Refunds for all students shall be processed in compliance with CEC § 94919/94920 (as applicable) and 5 CCR §71750.

Pursuant to 5 CCR section 75010(d), the Institution may do either of the following:

- (1) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, sign and return the notice to comply, declaring under penalty of perjury that the violation was corrected and describing how compliance was achieved; or
- (2) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, file with the Bureau a written notice of disagreement, specifying the minor violations described in the notice to comply with which the person approved to operate the institution disagrees, and appealing it by requesting an informal office conference. If a written notice of disagreement is not timely filed with the Bureau, the right to appeal is deemed to have been waived.

Pursuant to CEC section 94935(h), failure to comply with the notice to comply will result in the Bureau taking appropriate administrative enforcement action.
