

38	CEC §94897(e)	<p>Violation Description: The institution’s website and page 3 of the 2026 catalog contain statements that the institution is accredited.</p> <p>The BPPE records portray the institutions approval as non-accredited.</p> <p>Correction: The institution shall either provide documentation of accreditation OR if the Bureau’s records are correct, the institution shall update the catalog and website to remove the statements that they are accredited.</p>
39	CEC § 94913 (a)(1)	<p>Violation Description: The institution’s website contains a catalog with violations identified in this NTC.</p> <p>Correction: Once the institution's current catalog has been updated to remedy the violation(s), the institution shall update its website to provide the current/updated institution catalog pursuant to CEC § 94913(a)(1).</p>

Pursuant to 5 CCR section 75010(d), the Institution may do either of the following:

- (1) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, sign and return the notice to comply, declaring under penalty of perjury that the violation was corrected and describing how compliance was achieved; or
- (2) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, file with the Bureau a written notice of disagreement, specifying the minor violations described in the notice to comply with which the person approved to operate the institution disagrees, and appealing it by requesting an informal office conference. If a written notice of disagreement is not timely filed with the Bureau, the right to appeal is deemed to have been waived.

Pursuant to CEC section 94935(h), failure to comply with the notice to comply will result in the Bureau taking appropriate administrative enforcement action.

The Notice to Comply was given to the Institution's owner, person in control, chief academic officer, chief executive officer, chief operating officer, institution director, or any person delegated by any of the aforementioned persons to facilitate the inspection or accept such notice as set forth below.
