The institution's refund policy identifies the refund calculation in weeks, however according to Bureau records, the institution's programs are approved in hours.</p> <p>Correction: The institution shall update the pro-rata refund policy in the enrollment agreement pursuant to CEC § 94911(e)(2) and 5 CCR § 71750 (c)(1).</p>
9	CEC § 94913 (a)(1)	<p>Violation Description: The homepage of the institution's website failed to post the most current catalog.</p> <p>Correction: Once the institution's catalog has been updated to remedy the violations, the institution shall update its website to provide the current/updated school catalog pursuant to CEC § 94913 (a)(1).</p>
10	CEC § 94913 (a)(2)	<p>Violation Description: The institution failed to post on its website clear and conspicuous links to the school's 2023/2024 School Performance Fact Sheets for all programs offered by the school.</p> <p>Correction: The institution shall update its website to include a clear and conspicuous link to the school's 2023/2024 School Performance Fact Sheets for all programs offered by the school pursuant to CEC § 94913 (a)(2).</p>

11	CEC § 94913 (b)	<p>Violation Description: The institution failed to post on the bottom banner of the website, information where students may access the Bureau’s internet website where the institution identified itself as being approved by the Bureau</p> <p>Correction: The institution shall update its website to include information where students may access the Bureau’s internet website where the institution identified itself as being approved by the Bureau, pursuant to CEC § 94913 (b).</p>

Pursuant to 5 CCR section 75010(d), the Institution may do either of the following:

- (1) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, sign and return the notice to comply, declaring under penalty of perjury that the violation was corrected and describing how compliance was achieved; or
- (2) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, file with the Bureau a written notice of disagreement, specifying the minor violations described in the notice to comply with which the person approved to operate the institution disagrees, and appealing it by requesting an informal office conference. If a written notice of disagreement is not timely filed with the Bureau, the right to appeal is deemed to have been waived.

Pursuant to CEC section 94935(h), failure to comply with the notice to comply will result in the Bureau taking appropriate administrative enforcement action.

The Notice to Comply was given to the Institution’s owner, person in control, chief academic officer, chief executive officer, chief operating officer, institution director, or any person delegated by any of the aforementioned persons to facilitate the inspection or accept such notice as set forth below.
