1	CEC § 94909 (a)(9) in conjunction with 5 CCR § 71800 (e)	<p><b>Violation Description:</b> The institution’s 2025 catalog failed to mark the “Registration Fee” and “STRF fee” as nonrefundable, as is demonstrated in the institution’s enrollment agreement.</p> <p><b>Correction:</b> The institution shall update its 2026 catalog to mark the above-mentioned fees as nonrefundable pursuant to CEC § 94909 (a)(9) in conjunction with 5 CCR § 71800 (e).</p>
2	CEC § 94909 (a)(10)	<p><b>Violation Description:</b> The institution’s 2025 catalog failed to contain whether the institution participates in state financial aid programs, and, if so, all consumer information that is required to be disclosed to the student pursuant to state financial aid programs.</p> <p><b>Correction:</b> The institution shall update its 2026 catalog to include the above-mentioned disclosure pursuant to CEC § 94909 (a)(10).</p>

3	5 CCR § 71810 (b)(11)	<p><b>Violation Description:</b> The institution's 2025 catalog failed to contain the approximate number of days that will elapse between the institution's receipt of student lessons, projects, or dissertations and the institution's mailing of its response or evaluation.</p> <p><b>Correction:</b> The institution shall update its 2026 catalog to include the above-mentioned response time pursuant to 5 CCR § 71810 (b)(11).</p>
4	CEC § 94913 (a)(1)	<p><b>Violation Description:</b> The homepage of the institution's website failed to post the most current catalog.</p> <p><b>Correction:</b> Once the institution's catalog has been updated to remedy the violations, the institution shall update its website to provide the current/updated school catalog pursuant to CEC § 94913 (a)(1).</p>
5	5 CCR § 76140	<p><b>Violation Description:</b> The institution's 2025 4th Quarter STRF supporting documentation failed to contain record of the student's (5) Address at the time of enrollment and (11) Third-party payer identifying information.</p> <p>The institution's 2026 1st Quarter STRF supporting documentation failed to contain record of the student's (5) Address at the time of enrollment, (8) Course, (10) Quarter in which the STRF assessment was remitted to the Bureau, and (11) Third-party payer identifying information.</p> <p><b>Correction:</b> The institution shall update the institution's 2025 4th Quarter and 2026 1st Quarter STRF supporting documentation, pursuant 5 CCR § 76140 (a).</p>

Pursuant to 5 CCR section 75010(d), the Institution may do either of the following:

- (1) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, sign and return the notice to comply, declaring under penalty of perjury that the violation was corrected and describing how compliance was achieved; or
- (2) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, file with the Bureau a written notice of disagreement, specifying the minor violations described in the notice to comply with which the person approved to operate the institution disagrees, and appealing it by requesting an informal office conference. If a written notice of disagreement is not timely filed with the Bureau, the right to appeal is deemed to have been waived.

**Pursuant to CEC section 94935(h), failure to comply with the notice to comply will result in the Bureau taking appropriate administrative enforcement action.**

The Notice to Comply was given to the Institution's owner, person in control, chief academic officer, chief executive officer, chief operating officer, institution director, or any person delegated by any of the aforementioned persons to facilitate the inspection or accept such notice as set forth below.
