(2) The student may not be eligible for any other federal student financial aid at another institution or other government financial assistance until the loan is repaid.” <p>Correction: The institution shall update its enrollment agreement templates to contain the above-mentioned required statements.</p>
9	CEC § 94911 (d)	<p>Violation Description: The institution’s <i>DOCTOR OF PSYCHOLOGY DEGREE PROGRAM, MASTERS OF PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES (CAPSTONE PAPER TRACK) DEGREE</i>, and <i>MASTER OF HEALTHCARE ADMINISTRATION DEGREE</i> enrollment agreement templates failed to include a clear and conspicuous statement that the enrollment agreement is legally binding when signed by the student and accepted by the institution.</p> <p>Correction: The institution shall update its enrollment agreement templates to contain the above-mentioned required statements.</p>

Pursuant to 5 CCR section 75010(d), the Institution may do either of the following:

- (1) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, sign and return the notice to comply, declaring under penalty of perjury that the violation was corrected and describing how compliance was achieved; or
- (2) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, file with the Bureau a written notice of disagreement, specifying the minor violations described in the notice to comply with which the person approved to operate the institution disagrees, and appealing it by requesting an informal office conference. If a written notice of disagreement is not timely filed with the Bureau, the right to appeal is deemed to have been waived.

Pursuant to CEC section 94935(h), failure to comply with the notice to comply will result in the Bureau taking appropriate administrative enforcement action.

The Notice to Comply was given to the Institution's owner, person in control, chief academic officer, chief executive officer, chief operating officer, institution director, or any person delegated by any of the aforementioned persons to facilitate the inspection or accept such notice as set forth below.
