IT IS ORDERED THAT Defendant Guillermo Frias shall be prohibited and refrained from engaging, either directly or indirectly, in any activity or operation of Caledonian; [OR] Defendant Guillermo Frias, as Owner and Director of Caledonian, shall be prohibited from enrolling new students. This condition shall remain in effect until there is a final disposition of this criminal case or until further ordered by the Court.
