23 1. On May 10, 2021, Deborah Cochrane, Chief of the Bureau for Private Postsecondary
24 Education, Department of Consumer Affairs (Complainant), filed Statement of Issues No.
25 1006630 solely in her official capacity. On May 18, 2021, Complainant filed First Amended
26 Statement of Issues No. 1006630.

27 2. On or about June 26, 2020, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau)
28 received an Application for Significant Change in Method of Instructional Delivery from

1 California Beauty Academy (Respondent). On or about November 9, 2020, the Bureau denied
2 the Application. The Bureau received a letter from Respondent requesting an informal hearing.
3 Complainant requested the matter be scheduled for an informal hearing by the Office of
4 Administrative Hearings. The request was denied and the matter was scheduled as a formal
5 hearing on June 22, 2021.

6 3. On June 22, 2021, a hearing commenced before the Office of Administrative
7 Hearings. Due to Respondent's confusion regarding the formal hearing procedure, the
8 Administrative Law Judge ordered a continued hearing date of September 23, 2021.

9 4. During the hearing on June 22, 2021, Thanh Mai Thi Tran, on behalf of Respondent,
10 stated that Respondent desired to withdraw their request for a hearing.

11 5. On June 23, 2021, Respondent withdrew their appeal and request for a hearing of the
12 denial of their Application for Significant Change in Method of Instructional Delivery by the
13 Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education. Accordingly, Statement of Issues No. 1006630,
14 filed against Respondent, is withdrawn without prejudice and the denial of their application is
15 affirmed.

17 WHEREFORE, IN THE INTERESTS OF JUSTICE, Statement of Issues No. 1006630 is
18 hereby withdrawn without prejudice effective upon signature.
