Christina Villanueva issues this Citation: Assessment of Fine and Order of Abatement (Citation) in her official capacity as Discipline Manager of the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) of the California Department of Consumer Affairs.

CITATION

A Citation is hereby issued to Champion Institute of Cosmetology, Inc., OwneChampion Institute of Cosmetology, Inc., Owner of Champion Institute of Cosmetology, Inc. (Institution) located at 611 South Palm Canyon Drive #205, Palm Springs, CA 92264, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.9; California Education Code (CEC) section 94936; and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations (5, CCR) section 75020 for the violations described below.

BACKGROUND

On May 09, 2019, Bureau staff conducted an unannounced Compliance inspection at the Institution. As a result of ten minor violations that were unable to be cleared before the end of the inspection, the Institution was issued Notice to Comply #CU 3302111 0519 (NTC). The Institution was given thirty days from the date of the inspection to either remedy all violations listed in the NTC or submit a written Notice of Disagreement. A response was not received from the Institution within the timeframe of thirty days.

VIOLATION

#	Below you will find the California Education Code (CEC) and/or Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations (5, CCR code) section(s) of law you are charged with violating.
1.	<b>Violation:</b> <b>CEC Section 94935(b)(h) – Notice to Comply</b> <i>“(b) An institution that receives a notice to comply shall have no more than 30 days from the date of inspection to remedy the noncompliance.”</i>

*“(h) If an institution fails to comply with a notice to comply within the prescribed time, the bureau shall take appropriate administrative enforcement action.”*

The Institution failed to respond to the NTC within the prescribed time of 30 days. The Institution did not submit proof of compliance with the following laws and regulations:

COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER OF ABATEMENT

In accordance with the provisions of CEC section 94936 and 5, CCR section 75020 the Bureau hereby issues the order(s) of abatement described above. **Evidence of compliance with the order of abatement must be submitted, to the Bureau, within 30 days from the date of service of the Citation.**

APPEAL OF CITATION

You have the right to contest this Citation through an informal conference with the Bureau; and/or through an administrative hearing in accordance with Chapter 5 (Commencing with Section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code.

If you wish to contest this Citation, you must submit the ‘Notice of Appeal of Citation – Request for Informal Conference **and/or** Administrative Hearing’ form (enclosed) within 30 days from the date of service of the Citation. *If you do not request an informal conference **and/or** an administrative hearing within 30 days from the service of the Citation, you will not be able to request one at a later time.*

Unless a written request for an informal conference **and/or** an administrative hearing is signed by you and delivered to the Bureau by **October 17, 2019**, you will be deemed to have waived or forfeited your right to appeal this matter.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF CITATION

If you do not request an informal conference and/or an administrative hearing, this Citation shall become effective on **September 17, 2019**. Payment of the administrative fine and evidence of compliance with the order(s) of abatement shall be due by **October 17, 2019**. Your payment of the administrative fine shall not constitute an admission of the violation(s) charged.

If a hearing is requested, you will not be required to comply with this Citation until 30 days after a final order is entered against you.
