On May 12, 2016, an informal conference was held in the matter of Citation: Assessment of Fine and Order of Abatement No. 1516072 (Citation) against Mikhail Portnov, Owner of Portnov Computer School. In attendance were Robert Bayles, Enforcement Chief, Yvette Johnson, Enforcement Chief, Lana Portnov and Mikhail Portnov, Owners.

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code, §148; California Education Code (CEC), §94944; and Title 5 of California Code of Regulations (5 CCR), §75020 and §75040, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) renders the following decision relative to your appeal of the Citation No. 1516072.

It is the decision of the Enforcement Chief that on May 12, 2016, Citation No. 1516072 is modified and makes the following change(s):

VIOLATION CODE SECTIONS

#	The California Education Code (CEC) and the California Code of Regulations (CCR). Below you will find the section(s) you are charged with violating.
1.	<p>MODIFIED</p> <p>Violation: CEC 94913(a)(2)(5) - Required Web Site Information <i>"(a) An institution that maintains an Internet Web site shall provide on that Internet Web site all of the following:</i> (2) A School Performance Fact Sheet for each educational program offered by the institution. (5) The institution's most recent annual report submitted to the bureau."</p>

Bureau staff reviewed Portnov Computer School's website at www.portnov.com during a complaint investigation on May 28, 2015 and again on April 6, 2016. The review showed that Portnov Computer School failed to attach any School Performance Fact Sheets or its most recent Annual Report to its website.

Order of Abatement:

The Bureau hereby orders Portnov Computer School to update its website to include all of the website requirements in compliance with CEC 94913 including, but not limited to, the School Performance Fact Sheets and most recent Annual Report submitted to the Bureau.

Assessment of Fine

The fine for this violation is \$5000.00

Reason for modification: The institution's website is now in compliance.

The administrative fine for this violation has been modified from \$5,000.00 to \$100.00

TOTAL MODIFIED ADMINISTRATIVE FINE DUE: \$100.00

APPEAL OF CITATION

You *do not* have the right to request another Informal Conference to appeal this modified Citation. You *do*, however, have the right to appeal this modified Citation through an Administrative Hearing, *only if* you initially requested one within 30 days from the issuance date of the original citation. A hearing before an Administrative Law Judge will be scheduled and you will be notified of the hearing date. The hearing will be held pursuant to Chapter 5 (commencing with section 11500) of Part 1 of Division 3 of Title 2 of the Government Code. If you did not initially request an Administrative Hearing within 30 days from when the original citation was issued, you can no longer request one.


EFFECTIVE DATE OF CITATION AND FINE ASSESSMENT
