Violation	Code Section Violated	Description of the violation and required correction.
1	5, CCR § 71810 (b)(2)	Violation Description: Page 2 of the institution's catalog include the institution's mission and purposes, however failed to contain the objectives underlying each of its educational programs.  Correction: The institution shall update the above information in the catalog, pursuant to 5, CCR § 71810 (b)(2).

2	CEC § 94897 (s) in conjunction with Cal. Civ. Code §1788.93	Violation Description: Page 44 of the institution's catalog contains statement that the official transcripts will be released to students who are current with their financial obligation. This statement violates California Civil Code 1788.93 referenced below.
		CA Civ Code § 1788.93.  Notwithstanding any provision of law, a school shall not do any of the following:  (a) Refuse to provide a transcript for a current or former student on the grounds that the student owes a debt.  (b) Condition the provision of a transcript on the payment of a debt, other than a fee charged to provide the transcript.  (c) Charge a higher fee for obtaining a transcript or provide less favorable treatment of a transcript request because a student owes a debt.  (d) Use transcript issuance as a tool for debt collection.
		<b>Correction:</b> The institution shall remove the noncompliant statements from page 44 of the catalog, pursuant to CEC § 94897 (s) in conjunction with Cal. Civ. Code §1788.93.

8	CEC § 94909 (a)(13)	<b>Violation Description:</b> The institution's catalog failed to contain a description of the nature and extent of the placement services, if provided by the institution.

9	5, CCR § 71810 (b)(13)(B).	Violation Description: The institution's catalog failed to include the availability of housing located reasonably near the institution's facilities and an estimation of the approximate cost or range of cost of the housing.

		<b>Correction:</b> The institution shall update the fee section on page 2 of the enrollment agreement pursuant to CEC §94911 (e)(1) in conjunction with CEC §94920 (b).

Pursuant to 5 CCR section 75010(d), the Institution may do either of the following:

- (1) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, sign and return the notice to comply, declaring under penalty of perjury that the violation was corrected and describing how compliance was achieved; or
- (2) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, file with the Bureau a written notice of disagreement, specifying the minor violations described in the notice to comply with which the person approved to operate the institution disagrees, and appealing it by requesting an informal office conference. If a written notice of disagreement is not timely filed with the Bureau, the right to appeal is deemed to have been waived.

Pursuant to CEC section 94935(h), failure to comply with the notice to comply will result in the Bureau taking appropriate administrative enforcement action.
