3. On or about August 3, 2023, Respondent was served with Citation	on No. 2324031
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- 4. On or about August 31, 2023, Respondent submitted an appeal, requesting a hearing in this matter.
- 5. On, September 20, 2024, a Notice of Hearing was served by mail at Respondent's address of record which was and is: 3170 De La Cruz Blvd, Suite 107, Santa Clara, CA 95054. The Notice of Hearing informed them that an administrative hearing in this matter was scheduled for March 19, 2025.
- 6. Service of the Citation was effective as a matter of law under the provisions of Government Code section 11505(e) and/or Business and Professions Code section 124.
- 7. The matter was called for hearing at the date, time and location set forth in the Notice of Hearing. The assigned Administrative Law Judge found that the service of the Notice of Hearing on Respondent was proper. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Respondent. A default was declared and on motion of counsel for Complainant, the matter was remanded to the Bureau under Government Code section 11520.
  - 8. Government Code section 11506(c) states, in pertinent part:
  - (c) The respondent shall be entitled to a hearing on the merits if the respondent files a notice of defense... and the notice shall be deemed a specific denial of all parts of the accusation... not expressly admitted. Failure to file a notice of defense... shall constitute a waiver of respondent's right to a hearing, but the agency in its discretion may nevertheless grant a hearing.
  - 9. California Government Code section 11520(a) states, in pertinent part:
  - (a) If the respondent either fails to file a notice of defense... or to appear at the hearing, the agency may take action based upon the respondent's express admissions or upon other evidence and affidavits may be used as evidence without any notice to respondent....
- 10. Pursuant to its authority under Government Code section 11520, the Director finds Respondent is in default. The Director will take action without further hearing and, based on the relevant evidence contained in the Default Decision Investigatory Evidence Packet in this matter, finds that the charges and allegations in Citation No. 2324031, are separately and severally, found to be true and correct by clear and convincing evidence.

# DETERMINATION OF ISSUES

- Based on the foregoing findings of fact, Respondent Knowledge Innovations
   Academy has subjected its Approval to Operate Institution Code No. 4307321 to citation.
  - 2. The agency has jurisdiction to adjudicate this case by default.
- 3. The Director of the Department of Consumer Affairs is authorized to issue a citation against Respondent's Approval to Operate Institution Code No. 4307321 based upon the following violations alleged in the Citation which are supported by the evidence contained in the Default Decision Investigatory Evidence Packet in this case:
- a. California Code of Regulations, title 5, section 74110 Annual Report in conjunction
   with California Education Code section 94934 Annual Report.

# ORDER

IT IS SO ORDERED that Citation No. 2324031, issued to Respondent Knowledge Innovations Academy, is affirmed.

Pursuant to Government Code section 11520, subdivision (c), Respondent may serve a written motion requesting that the Decision be vacated and stating the grounds relied on within seven (7) days after service of the Decision on Respondent. The agency in its discretion may vacate the Decision and grant a hearing on a showing of good cause, as defined in the statute.
