18 TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES:

19 1. On or about June 1, 2005, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau)
20 issued a temporary Approval to Operate Institution Code 86815186 to Vista IT Training
21 (Respondent), owned by Brian Yung. On or about August 4, 2006, the Bureau issued a Full
22 Approval to Operate to Respondent. The Approval to Operate expired on January 18, 2022.

23 2. On or about March 8, 2022, the Bureau received from Respondent an Application for
24 Renewal of Approval to Operate and Offer Educational Programs for Non-Accredited Institutions
25 (Renewal Application), dated March 4, 2022. Between April 19, 2022 and June 12, 2024, the
26 Bureau and Respondent exchanged letters detailing the deficiencies in Respondent's Renewal
27 Application and attempts to cure those deficiencies, respectively. On or about July 19, 2024, the
28 Bureau denied the Renewal Application via a Notice of Denial of Application for Renewal of

1 Approval to Operate (Notice of Denial). On or about September 17, 2024, Respondent submitted
2 to the Bureau a request for administrative hearing.

3 3. On or about February 28, 2025, Deborah Cochrane (Complainant) filed Statement of
4 Issues No. BPPE24-1018 solely in her official capacity as the Chief of the Bureau for Private
5 Postsecondary Education, Department of Consumer Affairs. After the filing of the Statement of
6 Issues, Respondent provided additional documents intended to resolve issues of non-compliance
7 in Respondent's Renewal Application.

8 4. The Bureau hereby withdraws Statement of Issues No. BPPE24-1018. The basis for
9 withdrawing the pending Statement of Issues Number BPPE24-1018 is that Respondent has now
10 provided the documentation necessary to cure the deficiencies in its renewal application.

11 5. WHEREFORE, IN THE INTERESTS OF JUSTICE, Statement of Issues No.
12 BPPE24-1018 is hereby withdrawn without prejudice.
