The school shall not use the terms approved to operate without including the definition of approval to operate. To remedy this violation the school shall clearly indicate that approval to operate means compliance with state standards as set forth in the California Private Postsecondary Education Act of 2009. An institution shall not do any of the following: (i) In any manner make an untrue or misleading change in, or untrue or misleading statement related to, a test score, grade or record of grades, attendance record, record indicating student completion, placement, employment, salaries, or financial information, including any of the following: (3) Any other record or document required by this chapter or by the bureau. CEC The website indicates the students will be pursuing training for §94897(j)(3) licensure exams in cosmetology, manicuring, skin care and/or massage therapy. There are no state licensure exams for massage therapy, there is only voluntary certification and students are not eligible unless the school is approved through the California Massage Therapy Council (CAMTC). The licensure statement for massage therapy is a false and misleading statement. To remedy this violation the school shall remove the statement regarding licensure for massage therapy from their website and all advertising, including but not limited to Google.
