2	CEC § 94906 (a)	Violation Description: The institution's enrollment agreement failed to contain a separate statement indicating how you provide the enrollment agreement, disclosures and statements to students when they are unable to understand the terms and conditions of the enrollment agreement due to English not being their primary language.
		Correction: The institution shall update their 2025 catalog to contain the above statements, pursuant to CEC § 94906 (a).
3	CEC § 94909 (a)(8)(B) in conjunction with CEC § 94920 (b)	Violation Description: The institution's enrollment agreement contains an unenforceable statement regarding nonrefundable fees:

		This is unenforceable during the cancellation period. Institutions shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or application fee not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), if notice of cancellation is made through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.
		Correction: The institution shall update their enrollment agreement to comply with the above section of the code, or remove the "non refundable" language, pursuant to CEC § 94920 (b).

Pursuant to 5 CCR section 75010(d), the Institution may do either of the following:

- (1) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, sign and return the notice to comply, declaring under penalty of perjury that the violation was corrected and describing how compliance was achieved; or
- (2) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, file with the Bureau a written notice of disagreement, specifying the minor violations described in the notice to comply with which the person approved to operate the institution disagrees, and appealing it by requesting an informal office conference. If a written notice of disagreement is not timely filed with the Bureau, the right to appeal is deemed to have been waived.

Pursuant to CEC section 94935(h), failure to comply with the notice to comply will result in the Bureau taking appropriate administrative enforcement action.

The Notice to Comply was given to the Institution's owner, person in control, chief academic officer, chief executive officer, chief operating officer, institution director, or any person delegated by any of the aforementioned persons to facilitate the inspection or accept such notice as set forth below.
