The Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education (Bureau) issues this Notice to Comply pursuant to California Education Code (CEC) section 94935 and Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations (5 CCR) section 75010.

1	CEC §94909 (a)(3)(A)	<b>Violation Description:</b> On pages 3 and 18 of the catalog, the institution listed an outdated Bureau Phone Number. The current Bureau phone number is (916) 574-8900.	
		<b>Correction:</b> To remedy this violation, the institution must update the Bureau phone number on pages 3 and 18 of its catalog. Provide evidence to confirm the correction has been made to comply with CEC § 94909 (a)(3)(A).	
2	CEC § 94909 (a)(9), consistent with 5 CCR § 76120 (a)	<b>Violation Description:</b> On pages 37, 42, 47, and 53 of the catalog, the institution listed the scheduled total charges for a period of attendance and an estimated schedule of total charges for the entire educational program. However, the institution failed to list the Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF) Fee (nonrefundable). Pursuant to 5 CCR § 76120 (a) the current STRF fee is \$2.50 per \$1,000.00.	
		<b>Correction:</b> To remedy this violation, the institution must correctly list the STRF Fee (nonrefundable) as \$2.50 per \$1,00.00 on pages 37, 42, 47, and 53 of the catalog.

		Provide evidence to confirm the correction has been made to comply with CEC § 94909 (a)(9), consistent with 5 CCR § 76120 (a).	
3	5, CCR § 71810 (b)(4)	<b>Violation Description:</b> On pages 5 and 58 of the catalog, the institution contained language proficiency information, including the level of English language proficiency required of students and the kind of documentation of proficiency, such as the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), that will be accepted However, the institution failed to contain in its catalog whether English language services, including instruction service and its cost.	
		<b>Correction:</b> To remedy this violation, the institution must contain in in its catalog whether English language services, including instruction such as ESL, are provided and, if so, the nature of the service and its cost. Provide evidence to confirm the correction has been made to comply with 5 CCR § 71810 (b)(4).	
4	5, CCR § 76215 (b)	<b>Violation Description:</b> On pages 5-6 of the catalog, the institution listed an outdated version of the Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF) disclosure pursuant to 5, CCR § 76215 (b).	
		<b>Correction:</b> To remedy this violation, the institution must replace the outdated version of STRF disclosure (b) on pages 5-6 of its catalog and replace it with the correct version pursuant to 5, CCR § 76215 (b), which must be verbatim. Provide evidence to confirm the correction has been made to comply with 5 CCR § 76215 (b).	

Pursuant to 5 CCR section 75010(d), the Institution may do either of the following:

(1) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, sign and return the notice to comply, declaring under penalty of perjury that the violation was corrected and describing how compliance was achieved; or

(2) Within 30 days from the date of the inspection, file with the Bureau a written notice of disagreement, specifying the minor violations described in the notice to comply with which the person approved to operate the institution disagrees, and appealing it by requesting an informal office conference. If a written notice of disagreement is not timely filed with the Bureau, the right to appeal is deemed to have been waived.

## Pursuant to CEC section 94935(h), failure to comply with the notice to comply will result in the Bureau taking appropriate administrative enforcement action.

The Notice to Comply was given to the Institution's owner, person in control, chief academic officer, chief executive officer, chief operating officer, institution director, or any person delegated by any of the aforementioned persons to facilitate the inspection or accept such notice as set forth below.
