23 1. On or about April 8, 2013, the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education
24 (“Bureau”) received an Application for Renewal of Approval to Operate an Institution Non-
25 Accredited from Vocational Technical School; Julio Cardoza (Respondent). The Bureau denied
26 the application on or about March 8, 2017. On or about May 8, 2017, Respondent submitted to
27 the Bureau a request for an Administration Hearing.

1 2. On or about August 6, 2018, Dr. Michael Marion, Jr., Chief of the Bureau for Private
2 Postsecondary Education, Department of Consumer Affairs, solely in his official capacity, filed
3 Statement of Issues No. 1002663 regarding the denial of Respondent's application. On or about
4 April 9, 2019, Respondent submitted to the Bureau a school closure plan. On or about April 15,
5 2019, Respondent submitted to the Bureau a Notice of Withdrawal of Request of Hearing.

6 3. WHEREFORE, IN THE INTERESTS OF JUSTICE, and pursuant to Respondent's
7 submission of a school closure plan to close its institution and its Notice of Withdrawal of
8 Request for Hearing, the Bureau hereby withdraws without prejudice, Statement of Issues No.
9 1002663.
