STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

A student who cancels the enrollment agreement within seven days (until midnight of the seventh day excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays) after signing the agreement will receive a refund of all monies paid except the non-refundable fees.

A student who cancels after seven days has until the end of first week of class to cancel. All requests for cancellation by the Student must be made in writing and mailed or hand delivered to the Registrar, Olivet University, 36401 Tripp Flats Rd, Anza, CA 92539. Cancellation is effective on the date written notice of cancellation is sent. A withdrawal may be effectuated by the student's written notice or by the student's conduct, including, but not necessarily limited to, a student's lack of attendance. If the institution sent first lesson and materials before an effective cancellation notice was received, the institution shall make a refund within 30 days after the student's return of the materials.
