STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

A student who cancels the enrollment agreement within seven days (until midnight of the seventh day excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays) after signing the agreement will receive a refund of all monies paid except the non-refundable fees.

A student who cancels after seven days has until the end of first week of class to cancel. Cancellation is effective on the date written notice of cancellation is sent.
