For the purpose of determining a refund under this section, a student shall be deemed to have withdrawn from a program of instruction when any of the following occurs:

- The student notifies the institution of the student's withdrawal or as of the date of the student's withdrawal, whichever is later.
- The institution terminates the student's enrollment for failure to maintain academic progress; failure to abide by the rules and policies stated in the catalog; absences in excess of maximum set forth by the institution; and/or failure to meet financial obligations to the school.
