

### **Definitions:**

- "Number of Students Who Began the Program" means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- "Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).
- "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- "Graduates Unavailable for Employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become
  incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or
  do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an
  accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student
  completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been
  reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for
  which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of
  the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable
  educational program.
- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- "Number of Graduates Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.
- "First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.

#### STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

- 1. The student has the right to cancel and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh (7th) day after enrollment, whichever is later.
- 2. Student must exercise the right to cancel by the seventh (7th) calendar day after the scheduled program start date.
- 3. Students may withdraw from the School at any time after the cancellation period and receive a pro rata refund if they have completed 60 percent or less of the scheduled days in their program's current payment period through the last day of attendance. The refund will be less a registration or administration fee not to exceed \$150.00. If a Student has completed more than 60 percent of the period of attendance for which the Student was charged, the tuition is considered earned and the Student will not receive a refund.
- 4. Cancellation shall occur when the student provides notice of cancellation at the address of their respective campus. This can be communicated by mail, email or hand delivery.
- 5. The notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with proper postage.
- 6. A cancellation notice need not take any particular form and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement.
- 7. If an enrollment is cancelled, the school will refund the student any moneys/he paid, less a registration / administration fee not to exceed \$150.00, and less deductions for equipment not returned in good condition, within 45 days after the notice of cancellation is received.
- 8. Registration Fee is Non Refundable if cancellation request is received more than 3 calendar days after signing the enrollment agreement.
