## Definitions

“Number of Students Who Began the Program” means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.

“Students Available for Graduation” is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.

“Number of On-time Graduates” is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.

“On-time Completion Rate” is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.

“150% Graduates” is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).

“150% Completion Rate” is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.

“Graduates Available for Employment” means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.

“Graduates Unavailable for Employment” means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.

“Graduates Employed in the Field” means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months’ period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.

### STUDENTS RIGHT TO CANCEL

You have the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session \_\_\_/\_\_\_/\_\_\_ (date), or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. Cancellation occurs when you give written notice of cancellation at the institution's address. You can do this by mail, in person, by fax or telegram. The notice, if mailed is effective by postmark date. This notice need not take any particular form; it needs only to state that you wish to cancel this agreement. If you cancel this agreement, **Sri Sai Krish Institute** will refund any money that you paid, less any deductions for equipment not timely returned in new condition within 45 days after receipt of the notice.

**WITHDRAWAL FROM COURSE:** The institutional refund policy for students who have completed 60 percent or less of the course of instruction shall be a pro rata refund. After the end of the cancellation period, you have a right to terminate your studies at this school at any time, and you have the right to receive a refund for the part of the course or program you have paid for and did not receive. You have the right to withdraw from the course of instruction at any time. If you withdraw from the course of instruction after the period allowed for cancellation, the school will remit a refund, less a registration fee, within 45 days following your withdrawal. “Placement Rate Employed in the Field” is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.

“Number of Graduates Taking Exam” is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.

“First Available Exam Date” is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.

“Passage Rate” is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.

“Number Who Passed First Available Exam” is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.

“Salary” is as reported by graduate or graduate’s employer.

“No Salary Information Reported” is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.

### STUDENTS RIGHT TO CANCEL

You have the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session \_\_\_/\_\_\_/\_\_\_ (date), or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. Cancellation occurs when you give written notice of cancellation at the institution's address. You can do this by mail, in person, by fax or telegram. The notice, if mailed is effective by postmark date. This notice need not take any particular form; it needs only to state that you wish to cancel this agreement. If you cancel this agreement, **Sri Sai Krish Institute** will refund any money that you paid, less any deductions for equipment not timely returned in new condition within 45 days after receipt of the notice.

**PROCEDURE TO CANCEL:** Cancellation occurs when you give written notice of cancellation to the **Director of Student Services, 12362 Beach Blvd, suite 21, Stanton, CA 90680**. You can do this by mail, email, in person, by fax or telegram. The notice, if mailed is effective by postmark date. This notice need not take any particular form; it needs only to state that you wish to cancel.

**WITHDRAWAL FROM COURSE:** The institutional refund policy for students who have completed 60 percent or less of the course of instruction shall be a pro rata refund. After the end of the cancellation period, you have a right to terminate your studies at this school at any time, and you have the right to receive a refund for the part of the course or program you have paid for and did not receive. You have the right to withdraw from the course of instruction at any time. If you withdraw from the course of instruction after the period allowed for cancellation, the school will remit a refund, less a registration fee, within 45 days following your withdrawal. You are obligated to pay only for educational services rendered and for unreturned books or equipment.

*(A) Deduct a registration fee from (\$100) the total tuition charge.*

*(B) Divide this figure by the number of days in the course.*

*(C) The quotient is the daily charge for the course.*

*(D) The amount owed by you for purposes of calculating a refund is derived by multiplying the total days attended by the daily charge for instruction.*

*(E) The refund would be any amount in excess of the figure derived in (D) that was paid by you.*

*(F) The refund amount shall be adjusted for equipment, if applicable.*

If you receive federal student financial aid funds, you are entitled to a refund of moneys not paid from federal student financial aid program funds. If you obtain a loan to pay for your educational program, you will have the responsibility to repay the full amount of the loan plus interest, less the amount of any refund. If you are eligible for a loan guaranteed by the federal or state government and you default on the loan, both of the following may occur:

(1) The federal or state government or a loan guarantee agency may take action against you, including applying any income tax refund to which you are entitled, to reduce the balance owed on the loan.

(2) You may not be eligible for any other federal student financial aid at another institution or other government assistance until the loan is repaid.
