Definitions

- "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- "Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).
- "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- "Graduates Unavailable for Employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become
 incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States
 or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in
 an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

A notice of cancellation shall be in writing, and a withdrawal may be effectuated by the student's written notice or by the student's conduct, including, but not necessarily limited to, a student's lack of attendance. Internexus San Diego shall refund 100 percent of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or application fee not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), if notice of cancellation is made through your attendance at the first class session or the seventh day after signing this enrollment agreement, whichever is later. If you attend the first scheduled day of classes (or receive the first lesson on the date the course is scheduled to begin), the last date you have to cancel is _______. There is no penalty or obligation from the date the student cancels their enrollment agreement. The institution shall pay or credit refunds within 45 days of a student's cancellation or withdrawal. If the school has given a student any equipment, she/he must return the equipment within 10 days of the cancellation notice. If it is not returned within this time, Internexus San Diego may keep an amount out of the fees paid that equals the replacement cost of the equipment. The school will refund any amount over that and the student may keep the equipment.
