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REFUNDS: The refund policy for students who have completed 60 percent or less of the period of attendance shall be a pro rata refund. According to California Code of Regulations, a pro rata refund pursuant to section 94919(c) or 94920(d) or 94927 of the Code shall be no less than the total amount owed by the student for the portion of the educational program provided subtracted from the amount paid by the student. The amount owed equals the daily charge for the program (total institutional charge, divided by the number of days in the program), multiplied by the number of days remaining in the paid period of attendance after subtracting days the student attended, or was scheduled to attend, prior to withdrawal. (Please note that if a student is present for at least one day of a scheduled week, the remaining days of that scheduled week are also included for calculation purposes.) For instance, the daily charge of the program tuition fee is \$17.85 (\$500 divided by 28 days). If a student has paid \$1500 for 84 days (12 weeks), and he/she only attended classes for 14 days, the total refund will be \$1250, which is calculated from \$1500 (the total amount the student has paid) - \$250 (\$17.85 daily charge, multiplied by 14 days).
