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Definitions

- "Students available for graduation" is the number of students who began program minus
 the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military
 duty.
- "Number of On-Time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program with 100% of the program length with in the reported calendar year.
- "On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program. (Includes on-time graduates)
- "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the Number of Students Available for Graduation.

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

You have the right to cancel this agreement for a course of instruction including any equipment such as books, materials and supplies or any other goods related to the instruction offered in this Agreement, through attendance at the first-class session, or the seventh day after enrollment whichever is later for a refund of the "tuition" amount. Cancellation shall occur when you give written notice of cancellation at the address of the School shown on the top of the first page of the Enrollment Agreement. You can do this by mail, hand delivery or fax. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addresses with postage prepaid. If you cancel this Agreement, the School will refund any money that you paid, less any deduction for equipment not timely returned in good condition, within thirty days after your Notice of Cancellation is received. The institutional refund policy for students who have completed 60 percent or less of the course of instruction shall be a pro rata refund. If you withdraw from the course of instruction after the period allowed for cancellation of the Agreement, which is until midnight of the first business day following the first class you attended. the School will remit a refund less a registration fee, if applicable not to exceed \$98.00 within thirty days following your withdrawal. You are obligated to pay only for educational services rendered and for unreturned equipment. The refund shall be the amount you paid for instruction multiplied by fraction, the numerator of which is the number of hours of instruction which you have not received but for which you have paid, and the denominator of which is the total number of hours of instruction for which you paid.
