#### **Definitions**

#### **Cancellation and Refund Policy**

Registration Fee is non-refundable once submitted. Students have the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first-class session, or the 7th day after enrollment, whichever is later. (Meets CEC 94909(a)(8)(B) requirements)

- Non-refundable fees and time spent in the program will not be refunded.
- If you choose to cancel this agreement, AFPD will refund any money that you paid less specified non-refundable fees.
- Cancellation shall occur when you give written notice of cancellation addressed to CE Program Director and send by US certified mail, or hand delivered.
- The written notice of cancellation is effective on the date received by AFPD The refund will be issued within 45 days of the notice of cancellation.

AFPD follows the refund guidelines set by the California Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education in accordance with 5 CCR 71750. You have the right to withdrawal from a course of instruction at any time. If you withdraw from a course of instruction after the period allowed for cancellation of the agreement set forth above, AFPD will issue a pro rata refund base on the amount owed for the portion of the educational program provided subtracted from the amount paid by the student calculated as follows: total tuitional charge divided by the number of days in the program, multiplied by the number of days student attended, or was scheduled to attend prior to withdrawal, less the amount paid by the student. All amounts paid in excess of what is owed as calculated above shall be refunded within (45) days of the student's withdrawal or cancellation. #### Withdrawal Procedure:

A student has the right to cancel and obtain a refund based on the (refund policy). To withdrawal from a program, student must:
