STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

You have the right to cancel this Agreement for a course of instruction including any equipment such as books, materials and supplies or any other goods related to the instruction offered in this Agreement, through attendance at the first class session, or the third day after enrollment, whichever is later. Business day means a day on which you were scheduled to attend a class session.

Cancellation shall occur when you give written notice of cancellation at the address of the School shown on the top of the first page of the Enrollment Agreement. You can do this by mail, hand delivery or telegram. The written notice of cancellation is sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with postage prepaid.

The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, is effective if it shows that you no longer wish to be bound by this Agreement. You will be given two (2) Notice of Cancellation forms [attached to this Agreement] to use at the first day of class, but you can use any written notice that you wish.

If the school has given you any equipment, including books or other materials, you shall return them to the school within thirty days following the date of your Notice of Cancellation. If you fail to return this equipment, including books and other materials, in good condition within the thirty (30) day period, the School may deduct its documented cost for the equipment from any refund that may be due to you.
