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STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

Program Cancellation:

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Rejection of Applicant:

If an applicant is rejected for enrollment by AOI, or if a prospective student has his/her visa application rejected, a full refund of all monies paid will be made to the applicant, except for the \$150 non-refundable Application Fee.

Cancellation Prior to the Start of Class or No Show:

If a Student accepted by AOI cancels prior to the start of scheduled classes or never attends class (no-show), AOI will refund all monies paid except for the non-refundable \$150 Application Fee.

Withdrawal from Course: You have until this date:

The Student has until the date specified on his/her enrollment agreement to cancel or withdraw by notifying the office. The Student has the right to withdraw from School at any time. If the Student withdraws from the course of instruction after the cancellation period, the student will not be eligible to receive a refund. The school will remit a pro-rated refund for the unused portion of the tuition and other refundable charges if the Student has completed 60% or less of the instruction within 45 days. The refund is the amount calculated by deducting what the student owes for total hours of instruction completed from the total tuition charge.
