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Definitions

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STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

Students have the right to cancel their enrollment agreement or withdraw from their program at International College. Cancellation or withdrawal is effective only by way of written notice received by International College from the student.

Cancellation or withdrawal is effective only upon delivering written notice to the school in person or by mail. If sent by mail, cancellation or withdrawal is effective on the date written notice is sent to International College. It is the student's responsibility to verify that International College has received written notice.

A withdrawal may be effectuated by the student's written notice or by the student's conduct, including, but not necessarily limited to, a student's lack of attendance.

International College shall refund 100% of the amount paid for institutional charges, less a reasonable deposit or application fee not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), if notice of cancellation, is made through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.

If a student withdraws from the program after a period of attendance, the refund policy for students who have completed 60 % or less of the period of attendance shall be a pro rata refund less applications fees and nonrefundable charges outlined in the student enrollment agreement.

International College shall pay or credit refunds within 45 days of a student's cancellation. Refund will be sent to the original payer of the agreement.

You will be provided with a copy of the school's cancellation policy and form, which you may use to cancel your enrollment with the school.

A cancellation notice must be signed, dated and indicate that you no longer desire to be bound by the enrollment agreement or attend class.
