The student has a right to a full refund of all charges less than amount of \$250.00 for the registration fee and any other non-refundable items if he/she cancels this agreement prior to or in the first day of instruction or the seventh day after enrollment whichever is later. The amount retained for the registration fee may not exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00). In addition, the student may withdraw from a course after instruction has started and receive a pro-rated refund for the unused portion of the tuition and other refundable charge if the student has completed 60% or less of the instruction. For example, if the student completes only 30 hours of a 90-hour course and paid \$300.00 tuition. The student would receive a refund of \$200.00.

$(\$300.00 \text{ amount paid} \times (\text{unused hours } (60) / \text{total hours } (90))) = \$200.00 \text{ refund}$

The institution shall pay or credit refunds within 45 days of a student's cancellation or withdrawal.
