STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

1. You have the right to cancel your agreement for a program of instruction, without any penalty or obligation, through attendance at the first class session or the seventh calendar day after enrollment, whichever is later. - 3. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail, properly addressed with sufficient postage.
- 4. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, is effective if it shows that you no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement.

If the Enrollment Agreement is cancelled, the school will refund you any money you have paid within 45 days after the notice of cancellation is received or the first scheduled day of class, whichever is earlier, less an application fee of \$150.00, any non-refundable charges listed in this Enrollment Agreement and any deduction for equipment not returned in good condition.
