Definitions

- “Number of Students Who Began the Program” means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- “Students Available for Graduation” is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- “Number of On-time Graduates” is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.
- “On-time Completion Rate” is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- “150% Graduates” is the number of students who completed the program within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates).
- “150% Completion Rate” is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the number of students available for graduation.
- “Graduates Available for Employment” means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- “Graduates Unavailable for Employment” means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.



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- “Graduates Employed in the Field” means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable education program.
- “Placement Rate Employed in the Field” is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- “Number of Graduates Taking Exam” is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.
- “First Available Exam Date” is the date for the first available exam after a student completed a program.
- “Passage rate” is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.
- “Number who Passed First Available Exam” is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.
- “Salary” is as reported by graduate or graduate’s employer.
- “No Salary Information Reported” is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.



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STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL. The student has the right to cancel this Enrollment Agreement, without penalty or obligation, and obtain a refund of 100% of all amounts paid, less non-refundable fees and the STRF fee per semester, if notice of cancellation is given to the school prior to or on the first day of instruction or the 7th day after enrollment, whichever is later. The student may cancel this Agreement and obtain a refund on or before [date] _____ by giving written notice to:

The student must notify the school in writing either by mail, by hand delivery, by fax or by email.

The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when it is deposited in the mail properly addressed with postage prepaid. Refunds will be made to the student within 30 days of the effective date. The student should keep a record of the date, time and place of mailing any notice of cancellation.

STUDENT'S RIGHT TO WITHDRAW AND RECEIVE A REFUND. A student who has completed 60% or less of the program of instruction has the right to withdraw from the program and receive a refund of the unused portion of tuition fees and other reimbursable charges (*pro rata*). If the student withdraws from the program of instruction after the expiration of the time for canceling this Agreement, the student is obligated to pay only for educational services rendered, plus the non-refundable registration fee of \$30 per semester (or \$90 per year) and STRF fee. If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is only entitled to a refund of moneys not paid from federal student financial aid program funds. For an explanation of the student's right to withdraw and receive a refund, along with the kinds of expenses included in the refund, the student should read the explanation entitled "Explanation of Course Withdrawal and Refund Rights," which is attached to and included as a part of this Agreement.
