Definitions

If mailed in, the cancellation note becomes effective as of the postmark if properly addressed with proper postage. You will receive a complete refund within 30 days of course cancellation. You must return all equipment and materials to the school within the 30 days cancellation period, or the cost of the equipment and materials will be deducted from your refund.
