Definitions

- "Number of Students Who Began the Program" means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled
 to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all

- 2. Cancellation may occur when the student provides a written notice of cancellation at the following Mayfield College addresses: 35-325 Date Palm Drive, Suite 101, Cathedral City, CA 92234 and 73680 Buena Vista Drive, Twentynine Palms, CA 92277. This can be done by mail or by hand delivery.
- 3. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with proper postage.
- 4. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement.
- 5. If the Enrollment Agreement is cancelled the school will refund the student any money he/she paid, less a registration or administration fee not to exceed \$100.00, and less any deduction for equipment not returned in good condition, within 45 days after the notice of cancellation is received.
